

# Accept Feedback – Activity 1 – Lesson



## ***Purpose:***

We want to teach our child(ren) to Accept Feedback. Feedback is intended to help. When they Accept Feedback, they will make fewer mistakes and be more successful in life.

## ***Materials:***

Image of Accept Feedback Poster

## ***Lesson:***

This week we teach how to Accept Feedback. Feedback is information about something the child has done. It can be to encourage the positive, or Feedback can be given on something that needs to be corrected.

First – Say the steps and have your child(ren) repeat them after you. You can create hand gestures to go along with the steps, which help the children remember.

Second – Talk about the reasons and situations when it is important to Accept Feedback.

Third – Practice. Role play a time when your child would need to Accept Feedback. For example, your child was told to clean up their room, and you give them Feedback to go back and pick up the toys under their bed. They need to Look, Listen (without arguing) and Use to Improve – go back and clean up the toys.

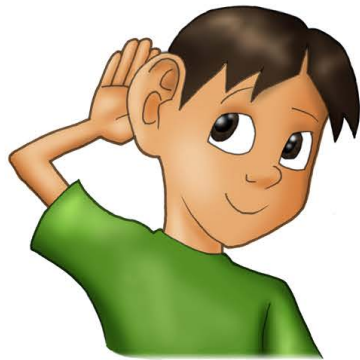
