

Get the Teacher's/Person's Attention – Activity 1 - Lesson



Purpose:

We want to teach our child(ren) to Get the Teacher's/Person's Attention respectfully. When children Get other's Attention without interrupting, they are more likely to receive the Attention they want. And, they will get along better with others.

Materials:

Lesson:

This week we teach how to Get the Teacher's/Person's Attention.

First – Say the steps and have your child(ren) repeat them after you. You can create hand gestures to go along with the steps, which help the children remember. When at home, talk about ways to Get an Adult's Attention, without the step of raising your hand.

Second – Talk about the reasons and situations when it is important to Get the Teacher's/Person's Attention.

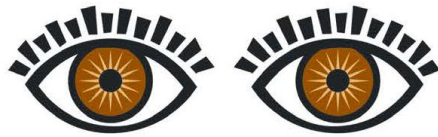
Third – Practice. Role play a time when your child would need to Get your Attention. For example, if you are talking to another adult or you are on the phone, they need to Look and Wait Quietly until you are available to attend to their need.
