Project Summary & How Your Club Can Help Services & Benefits & Funding Options

The focus of relationships with individual Rotary Clubs-Districts in different community locations links to our Project CLASS for Community initiative. This initiative provides contact, services and resources to individual teachers, parents, grandparents, foster parents, other caring adults through offerings on our projectclass.org website and contact with our Help-Line Resources Liaison. The Help-Line personal connection customizes content on our website for the individual needs and situations of the Rotarians seeking assistance. Additionally, we provide Virtual Training sessions through Zoom and are in the process of developing On-Demand Virtual Training sessions.

We are seeking relationships with individual Rotary Clubs-Districts for two reasons.

First, we know that our curriculum of core-foundation social skills, activities and experiences improve the behavior, focus of attention and learning readiness of children 3-12 years old with a cascade of benefits for their learning and relationships.

Maximizing availability and spreading the word of our offerings helps local communities in very tangible ways.

Second, funding from Rotary funds:

- Content Development and Website Access
- On-Line Training Sessions (Live & On-Demand)
- Help-Line Resources Liaison
- Social Media & Outreach

In response to requests from individual Rotary Clubs-Districts, we have striated 3 levels of possible support. The difference in services offered between the levels of support link to the volume of On-Line Training services offered and the volume of Help-Line resourcing. We envision 3 packages of support: \$10,000; \$5,000; \$1,000 to \$3,000.

This relationship is a sustainable relationship because once content is developed and made accessible on our projectclass.org website, access to the website and the content are free and on-going.

Based on experience and evidenced by data, what we are proposing for our Rotary relationship will have beneficial outcomes, specifically as relates to improvements in children's behavior linked to core-foundation social skills- improved ability to Follow Instructions, Pay Attention, Calm Down When Angry, etc. Evaluation questionnaires are part of the services mix.
